Minutes from the April 2021 Meeting: Approved with a motion by Lee Vulcan and a second by Chuck Gardner. Motion carried.


<u>Finance Report</u>: April 2021 Approved with a motion by Lee Vulcan and a second by Bob Lowry. Motion carried.
